

Bricklaying Workshop.

- **Quantities Required for Brick BBQ using the www.brickwork.net.au plan.**
 - Concrete Base 1/4 Cubic Metre (2000x900x100mm).
 - Brickies Sand (good quality) 1/4 Cubic Metre.
 - Cement 3 x20 Kg bags.
 - Bricks x200
 - Pavers for capping, or solid bricks x12.
 - Concrete Stepping Stones, 2 x600x600x50mm
 - Lime, 1 shovel per bag of cement.

- A bbq is also required, it can be a gas bbq or a wood fired bbq its your choice, but it must be present at the time of building the brickwork to make sure it all fits together nicely.
 - Measurements from a brochure wont do as there is nothing worse than spending time building a bbq only to find that the burner or plate doesn't fit when you have finished.
 - If you going for a wood fired bbq you also need a grate on which to light the fire which will sit below the bbq plate, the grate can be a bit of weld mesh or similar.

- Always allow more for materials that you work out on paper, you always have to allow for wastage.
